bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
James M. Harris, Jr. and Jo Alice P. Harris, their heirs and assigns

all that tract or lot of land in  
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
on the South side of Mills Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No.  
39 on plat of Jane G. Hammond property known as Langley Heights made by  
Dalton & Neves, June 1937 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "N", at page 133 and having according to said plat  
the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Mills Avenue 252.6 feet from  
the intersection of Mills Avenue and Edgewood Drive and running thence  
with said Mills Avenue N. 39-17 E. 50 feet to a point on said Mills  
Avenue, joint corner of Lots 38 and 39; thence with the joint line of  
said lots 38 and 39, S. 50-43 E. 175.6 feet to a point on a 15-foot  
alley, joint rear corner of said lots 38 and 39; thence along the line  
of said 15-foot alley, S. 46-47 W. 50.43 feet to a point, joint rear
