WHEREAS, the said OAK GROVE CHURCH has in an open meeting of the members of the church on the 16TH day of March, 1952 elected and appointed the above named as trustees by resolution with full power to negotiate a loan to pay a part of the construction cost of a parsonage and to execute such notes, mortgages and other papers as may be necessary to secure said loan,

AND WHEREAS, said trustees have negotiated a loan as above authorized in the amount of two thousand five hundred (\$2, 500. 00) from the Commercial National Bank of Spartanburg, Landrum Office,

NOW THEREFORE, the said Oak Grove Church is well and truly indebted to the said Commercial National Bank of Spartanburg, Landrum Office in the sum of two thousand five hundred (\$2, 500. 00) dollars for which the said bank holds its note bearing interest payable monthly at the rate of 6% per annum on the unpaid principal sum executed by said trustees payable in monthly installments of forty-eight and 34/100 (\$48. 34) dollars each, the first installment to be due on the first day of May, 1952, and a like installment (\$48. 34) to be due on the first day of each callendar month thereafter until the full sum of \$2, 500. 00 with interest has been paid reference being thgreto had, will more fully appear.
