Lots 11, 12, 13 and 14 have the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING on the Northern side of Hampton Circle, corner of Lot 15 and thence with the Northern side of Hampton Circle N. 43 E. 313.3 feet to a pin; thence around the curve of Hampton Circle Northward 35.4 feet; thence with the West side of Hampton Circle N. 1-43 W. 155 feet to a pin and thence on a curve S. 88-16 W. 35.2 feet to a pin on the Southern side of Pitts Street; thence with the South side of Pitts Street S. 43 W. 315 feet to corner of Lot 15; thence with Lot 15; S. 47 E. 205 feet to the beginning corner as shown on said plat.
