Bishop in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Henry, as Committee for Carl R. Woodcock and Herbert L. Thruston

all that tract or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing forty-five acres, more or less, and being all of the tract of land which was conveyed to me, said W. R. Boling by B. M. McGee by deed dated June 18, 1919, and recorded in Deed Book 45, Page 606, in R. M. C. office for said Greenville County, and lying on east side of Paris Mountain, adjoining lands of South Carolina State Park, Rainey and others. Said tract originally contained fifty-one and one-half (51 1/2) acres, but I have conveyed two parcels therefrom; one of 4.45 acres I conveyed to Ella Mae Boling as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 202, page 238; and one of 2.06 acres which I conveyed to William D. Taylor recorded in Deed Book 270, page 363, leaving the remainder 45 acres herein mortgaged.
