TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, P. R. Long, Jr. and Mildred V. Long, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eight Thousand and No/100- - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 8,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of ~~six~~(5) five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, at the corner of Randall Street and Townes Street, and being known and designated as the Eastern one-half of Lot No. 39 of Block B as shown on Plat of Stone Land Company June 4, 1909, recorded in Plat Book A at Pages 337-347, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at the Southwestern corner of Randall Street and Townes Street, and running thence along the Western side of Townes Street, S. 1-41 W. 200 feet to a point in the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 39 and 40; thence along the common line of said lots, N. 83-13 W. 65.5 feet to a point in the rear line of said Lots Nos. 39 and 40; thence along the remaining portion of Lot No. 39, N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to a point on the Southern side of Randall Street; thence along the Southern side of said Street, S. 83-13 E. 65.5 feet to the point of beginning."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by B. A. Long by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 431 at Page 118.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
