located about two and one-half miles south from the village of Pelham  
lying on the south side of the Bennetts Bridge Road, and more fully  
described as follows:

Beginning on a nail and stopper in the center of the said Bennetts  
Bridge Road, joint corner with lot recently purchased by L. W. Ford,  
and running thence with said road, N. 36-54 W. 274.5 feet to a nail  
and stopper in the center of the said road; thence S. 23-30 W. 286  
feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63-15 E. 286 feet to an iron pin on
