To All Whom These Presents May Concern **ARNSWORTH**

We, Paul Balliew, Hall Hollifield, J. B. Howard, M. D. Moon, W. B. Crain, G. W. Nix & H. I. Willis as Deacons of Double Springs Baptist Church, an unincorporated membership hereinafter called the Mortgagor, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted to BANK OF GREER, GREER, S. C., hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of

to be paid as therein stated **Nine Thousand - - - - - DOLLARS,**

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the north side of a County Road known as Millford Road about 0.1 mile east of Double Springs Church and bounded by lands of Bouce Malonee, E. Few and N.H. Mullinax ~~containing~~ containing two and 37/100 (2.37) Acres, more or less, being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on north side of Road and running with Malonee's line N3-45 E. 990.3 feet to iron pin on Few line; thence S85-41E 98.3 feet to iron pin; thence S3-12W 965.6 feet to iron pin on northside of road; thence S80-54W 110.3 feet along road to beginning.
