I, Ella R. Batson, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:
WHEREAS, I the said Ella R. Batson
in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the
full and just sum of Five Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 (\$5,500.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of Fifty-Five and No/100
NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Ella R. Batson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment. thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, ac-

cording to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

Ella R. Batson in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the southwest corner of the intersection of Dukeland Drive and King Street, in the Sans Souci section of Greenville County about three miles north of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of the Perry property recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 49, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern edge of a 5-foot sidewalk running along Dukeland Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence along the southern edge of said sidewalk, N. 54-49 E. 53.5 feet to an iron pin on the western edge of a 5-foot sidewalk running along King Street; thence along the western edge of said sidewalk, S. 36-32 E. 125 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 4 and 7; thence along the northern line of Lot 7, S. 57-53 W. 91 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 4 and 7; thence along the eastern line of Lot 5, N. 20-06 W. 125 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same conveyed to me by Clarence C. Coleman, Jr. by deed dated August 19, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 462, at page 52."
