TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Willie T. Kimbrell (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-two Hundred and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 2,200.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 6 of Block 1 of Sheet WG 11 of the County Block Book, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of American Legion Fair Ground property, and the right-of-way of Southern Railway, which pin is 25 feet from the center of said railway, and running thence S. 46-00 W. 695 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of E. C. Trammell; thence with Trammell line, S. 42-00 E. 131.5 feet to an iron pin in another lot owned by E. C. Trammell; thence with Trammell line, N. 46-00 E. 222 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Trammell line, S. 42-00 E. 219.5 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly of E. F. James; thence with line of James property, N. 58-00 E. 360 feet to an iron pin in right-of-way of Southern Railway; thence with the right-of-way of said railway, N. 29-30 W. 216.5 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said right-of-way, N. 25-30 W. 231 feet to the beginning corner."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, if being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
