Amick in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Franklin National Life Insurance Company, its Successors and Assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 0.78 acres, more or less, and being known as Tract #7 and situate on the eastern side of the White Horse Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the White Horse Road at that corner of property now or formerly belonging to Mrs. Rowell and running thence N. 56-05 E. 148.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-0 E. 178.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-24 W. 60.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 85-36 W. 273.5 feet to an iron pin on the White Horse Road; thence with the eastern side of said road N. 1-24 E. 98 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
