NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee,

W.C. Henson and his heirs and assigns:

All that certain parcel or tract of land containing Forty Acres, more or less, situated on the West side of the Brushy Creek-Pelham Road, about four miles Southwest from Greer, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a portion of Tract No. 7 of the J.P. Greene Estate according to survey and plat by M.O. Owens, Surveyor, dated November 6, 1934, and being the same property conveyed to Clara Belle Harrison by deed of Flora G. McClimon, recorded in Deed Book 207, page 7, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, less approximately 2 acres conveyed therefrom.
