Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a tract of 66.35 acres lying on the northern side of the Augusta Road, as shown on a plat of the property of Milton G. Smith made August, 1923, by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and revised April, 1931 and December, 1941. The land mortgaged herein has, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stake in the center of the Augusta Road at the corner of property formerly belonging to Julia D. Charles, and running thence along the center of the Augusta Road S. 26-16 E. 500 feet to a stake; thence continuing with the center of the Augusta Road S. 46-0 E. 153.5 feet to a stake, corner of tract conveyed to H. J. Winn by the First National Bank of Greenville, S. C. and the tract conveyed to H. J.
