To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, William Washington and Ruth Washington **SEND GREETINGS:**

WHEREAS, we the said William Washington and Ruth Washington, of Greenville
South Carolina

in and by OUR certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, in the full and just sum of Four Thousand, One Hundred and No/100 - - - - (\$ 4,100.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Forty-One and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 41.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said William Washington and Ruth Washington

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us,

the said William Washington and Ruth Washington
in hand well and truly paid by the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and on south side of Sullivan street in the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in November of 1950, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Sullivan Street and a 10-foot alley, and running thence with the west side of said alley, S. 10-36 W. 137.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the north side of an alley in the rear of this lot, N. 85-15 W. 32 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-17 E. 135 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Sullivan street; thence with the south side of Sullivan street, S. 89-15 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner."

The above described lot is the same as conveyed to me by Nan G. Morgan by deed dated Dec. 9, 1950 being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 424, at page 521.
