P. M. Watts and Elizabeth J. Watts of Greenville, S. C., hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eleven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$ 11,200.00), with interest from date at the rate of four and one-half per centum (4½%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, S. C., or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Seventy and 90/100 Dollars (\$ 70.90), commencing on the first day of August, 19 53, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 19 73.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Northwesterly side of Alleta Avenue, in the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as a portion of Lot No. 37 and a portion of Lot No. 39 on the plat of Hillside Terrace as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "F", page 154, said lot, according to a survey made by R. W. Dalton dated June, 1953, fronting 81 feet on the Northwesterly side of Alleta Avenue and having a depth of 115.3 feet on the Northeasterly side, a depth of 98.3 feet on the Southwesterly side, and being 56 feet across the rear. The Southeasterly corner of said lot is located on the Northwesterly side of Alleta Avenue at a point 78.9 feet Southwest of the Westerly corner of the intersection of Alleta Avenue and Cleveirvine Avenue (formerly Hillside Avenue).

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.
