Whereas, I, the said A. B. Skelton

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All these two certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Welcome Road, being shown as lot No. 6 and a triangular section of lot No. 4, as shown on plat of property of O. T. White recorded in Plat Book O, at page 147, and described as follows:

Lot No. 6 Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Welcome Road, at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6 and running thence with line of lot No. 5, S. 57-50 W. 291 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-20 E 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-35 E. 316.1 feet to and iron pin on Welcome Road; thence with Welcome Road, N. 58-40 W. 96.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Portion of Lot No. 4: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Welcome Road, joint front corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with line of No. 5, S. 48-30 W. 161 feet to an iron pin in line of lot this day conveyed to Clarence S.
