the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

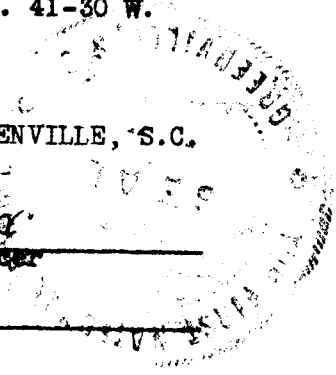
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Easterly side of Pisgah Drive, joint

81.1 feet to an iron pin common corner Lots 34, 35 and 36; thence N.
73-06 E. 120 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of an unnamed
road; thence along the Westerly side of the said unnamed road N. 16-54 W.
95 feet to a point; thence around the curve of the intersection of the
said unnamed road and Pisgah Drive, the chord of which is N. 65-21 W.
33.1 feet to a point on the Easterly side of Pisgah Drive; thence along
the Easterly side of Pisgah Drive S. 65-48 W. 69.2 feet to a point;
thence continuing along the Easterly side of Pisgah Drive S. 41-30 W.
86 feet to an iron pin to point of beginning.
