Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. on the south side of Camille Avenue in the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 10 and the western one-half of Lot No. 11 on plat of the property of the Estate of T. Q. Donaldson, said plat surveyed and made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1935 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 284 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Lot No. 10: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Camille Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence with the line of Lot No. 11, S. 8-45 W. 144.48 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-15 W. 71 feet to an iron pin, said pin being the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 9 and 10, N. 8-45 E. 140.12 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Camille Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the south side of Camille Avenue, S. 84-50 E. 71 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.

Western one-half of Lot No. 11: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Camille Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 10, S. 8-45 W. 144.48 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-15 E. 35.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot No. 11; thence through the center of Lot No. 11, N. 8-45 E. 146.66 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Camille Avenue, in the center of the front line of Lot No. 11; thence with the south side of Camille Avenue, N. 84-50 W. 35.5 feet to the beginning corner.
