WHEREAS, on July 5, 1947, the Board of Church Extension of the Methodist Episcopal Church South advanced the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars to St. Mark Methodist Episcopal Church of Greenville to be used in the erection of a church building on the property belonging to St. Mark Methodist Episcopal Church of Greenville at the Southeast corner of North Franklin Road and Ethelridge Drive near Greenville, S. C., and

Mark Methodist Episcopal Church of Greenville entered into an agreement with the Board of Church Extension of the Methodist Episcopal Church South which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 365, page 205 acknowledging said loan and conditional donation and further agreeing that in case the property described in said agreement should ever be alienated by the said Church or in case the said property should cease to be used for or devoted to other uses other than for a Methodist Church that said trustees acting for and in behalf of the St. Mark Methodist Episcopal Church of Greenville would refund to said Board the sum of money advanced and any interest due thereon and the payment thereof should be secured by a lien on said property particularly described in said agreement and

WHEREAS, the said St. Mark Methodist Episcopal Church of Green-ville is obtaining a loan in the amount of \$22,500.00, from Liberty Life Insurance Company of Greenville, the proceeds of which are to be used in purchasing a new parsonage located at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Blue Ridge Drive and Arbor Street, near the City of Greenville, and to pay the balance due on a mortgage held by Liberty Life Insurance Company on property located at the Southeast corner of the intersection of North Franklin Road and Ethelridge Drive near Greenville, and
