To All Whom These Presents May Concern: I, J. Euel Taylor

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said J. Euel Taylor

hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as trustee under agreement with Bessie Norris Tilman dated July 9, 1953 hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) -

- DOLLARS (\$) to be paid \$96.67 on the 7 day of November 1953 and alike amount on the 7 day of each and every month thereafter until the entire principal sum is paid in full, payments to be applied first in payment of interest and then to principal, with the right to anticipate the whole or any part of principal on any interest paying date

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as trustee under agreement with Bessie Norris Tilman dated July 9, 1953,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, state of South Carolina, Chick Springs Township, about 3 miles northwest of Greer, and being located on the St. Mark Road, and having according to a recent survey by H. S. Brockman, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of St. Mark Road, the same being the corner of Euel Taylor property, and running thence with the south side of St. Mark Road S. 26-05 W. 131 feet to an iron pin in line of property of J. E. Taylor; thence with line of the J. E. Taylor property S. 58-45 E. 519.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 26-36 E. 131 feet to an iron pin in line of property of Euel Taylor; thence with the line of property of Euel Taylor N. 58-45 W. 221.1 feet to the beginning corner.
