 VETERAN'S ADMINISTRATION LOAN # HG-1105-SC

THIS AGREEMENT made this 29th day of December, 1953, between the Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, a corporation, chartered under the laws of the United States, hereinafter called "FIDELITY", and Lucius R. Evans, hereinafter called "OBLIGOR" Witnesseth that:

WHEREAS Fidelity is the owner and holder of a note dated 11th day of May, 1946, executed by Lucius R. Evans and delivered to Fidelity in the original principal amount of \$3000.00 and secured by a mortgage upon said premises shown as Lot No. 4, Block 6, Sheet 174, on County Block Book, said premises being located on the East side of Furman Hall Road, 189 feet from the intersection with Chick Springs Road, said mortgage being recorded in said office in Book of Mortgages 345 at Page 3, title to which mortgaged premises is now vested in said Lucius R. Evans subject to said note and mortgage which are hereinafter called the obligation and said Obligor has requested Fidelity to extend the time for performance of the obligation; NOW THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That it is agreed in consideration of the mutual agreements herein that:

1. Fidelity agrees to extend the time for payment of the principal indebtedness of \$1929.96 now remaining unpaid under the obligation so that it shall be payable as follows: \$22.20 on the 1st day of February, 1954, and a like payment of \$22.20 upon the first day of each and every month thereafter until paid in full and if not sooner so paid, the balance on the first day of December, 1961, said payments to be applied first to interest at the rate of four per cent, the balance to principal.
