To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

 I, Annie Bell Stevens, of Greenville County,

SEND GREETINGS:

 WHEREAS, I the said Annie Bell Stevens

 in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, in the full and just sum of Four Thousand, Four Hundred and No/100 - - - (\$ 4,400.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

(\$) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

 NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Annie Bell Stevens

 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

 the said Annie Bell Stevens

 in hand well and truly paid by the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE**, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 32 and 33 of the property known as Nicholtown Heights, and having the following metes and bounds according to plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 4 as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwestern intersection of Mims Avenue and Watson Street, and running thence along Mims Avenue, N. 0-45 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 33 and 34; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 89-15 W 110 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 6; thence along the rear lines of Lots 6 and 7, S. 0-45 E. 80 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Watson Street; thence along Watson Street, N. 89-15 E. 110 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same conveyed to me by two deeds from Cora K. Chapman, the first being dated May 14, 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 479, at page 6, and the second being dated June 24, 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 480, at page 446."
