To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, S. L. Robertson, of Greenville County, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I the said S. L. Robertson

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of Seven Thousand, Three Hundred and No/100 - - - (\$ 7,300.00)

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

Seventy-Three and No/100 - - - - - \$ 73.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said S. L. Robertson

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said S. L. Robertson in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Meyers Court in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 21 on plat of Section C of Parkvale as per plat made by Dalton & Neves in July, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 54, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern side of Meyers Court at the corner of Lot 20, and running thence along the line of said lot, S. 82-00 E. 180 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence with the branch as the line, in a northeasterly direction, 104 feet, more or less, to a point at the corner of Lot No. 22; thence with the line of said lot, N. 82-00 W. 255 feet to a stake on Meyers Court; thence with the eastern side of Meyers Court, S. 7-30 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same conveyed to me by A. J. McKinney by deed dated July 7, 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 493, at page 230."
