have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 65 of a subdivision known as Lake Forest Section 1, according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, July, 1953, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Tranquil Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 64 and 65, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 33-08 W. 134.3 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 66; thence along the line of that lot, N. 55-46 W. 142 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Lake Fairfield Drive; thence along the southeast side of Lake Fairfield Drive, N. 25-15 E. 125.2 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Lake Fairfield Drive as the same converges with Tranquil Avenue, the chord of which is N. 63-08 E. 30.8 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Tranquil Avenue; thence along the southwest side of Tranquil Avenue, S. 50-30 E. 137.8 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same conveyed to me by Lake Forest, Inc. by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 492, at page 315."
