WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of United States of America, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$14,800.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four and one-half per centum (4½%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Ninety-Three and 68/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 93.68), commencing on the first day of May, 1954, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of April, 1974.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina: on the Northern side of Hillendale Circle, being the Western portion of Tract No. 10 as shown on Plat of property of J. M. Black, made by Dalton & Neves, in December, 1949, recorded in Plat Book S at Page 59 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northern side of Hillendale Circle and running thence N. 4-55 W. 66 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-57 E. 55 feet to a stake; thence N 25-31 E. 150 feet to a stake at corner of property of John W. and Evelyn M. Ray; thence with the line of said property S. 43-51 E. 152.8 feet to a stake on Hillendale Circle; thence with the Northern side of said circle the chord of which is S. 31-35 W. 33.5 feet to a stake; thence continuing with the Northern side of Hillendale Circle S. 60-11 W. 214.9 feet to the beginning corner.
