M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at pages 16 and 17, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Lullwater Road, joint front corner of Lots 38 and 39 and running thence with the line of Lot 39, N. 55-12 E. 207.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-48 W. 79 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Poppy Way; thence along the Southeast side of Poppy Way S. 54-56 W. 211.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Poppy Way and Lullwater Road; thence along the Northeast side of Lullwater Road S. 37-13 E. 78.1 feet to the beginning
