MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, W. H. Hamby, of Greenville County, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I the said W. H. Hamby

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the

full and just sum of Three Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100 - - - (\$ 3,900.00 )

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of

Thirty-Nine and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 39.00 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said W. H. Hamby

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said W. H. Hamby in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the eastern side of Mims Avenue (formerly Avenue B), being shown and designated as Lot No. 50 on plat of Nickeltown Heights No. 1 by C. M. Furman, Jr. Engr., June 7, 1922, checked and revised by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March, 1941, recorded in Plat Book "F", page 68 and Plat Book "M", page 5, in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on eastern side of Mims Avenue, joint front corner with Lot No. 51, which point is 40 feet north of Collins Street (formerly Taylor Street), and running thence N. 89-15 E. 110 feet to point, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 50, 51, 64 and 65; thence N. 0-45 W. 40 feet along rear line of Lot No. 65 to point, joint rear corner Lots Nos. 49, 50, 65 and 66; thence S. 89-15 W. 110 feet along line of Lot No. 49 to point on eastern side of Mims Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Mims Avenue, S. 0-45 E. 40 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by L. P. Hollis by deed dated May 27, 1954, not yet recorded."
