MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:
I, Clarence E. D'Oyley, Jr., individually and as Trustee for Clarence E. D'Oyley, Jr., and Alice D'Oyley Knuckles, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Trustee for Oconee Memorial Park Perpetual Upkeep Trust Fund, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

-----One Thousand and No/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$ 1000.00),
with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$30.43 on July 21, 1954, and a like payment of \$30.43 on the 1st day of each successive month thereafter, until paid in full, said payments to be first applied to interest, and the balance to principal.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the North side of Dunbar Street (formerly Nichols Street) in the City of Greenville, and being shown and designated as lot No. 14-A, Section 3, on Page 82 of the City Block Book, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Dunbar Street, at corner of lot formerly owned by Gower, Cox and Markley, and running thence N. 11 E. 139 feet to stake in line of lot formerly owned by W. C. Brown; thence with the line of said lot, N. 78 1/2 W. 40 feet to stake at corner of lot No. 15, as shown on City Block Book; thence with the line of said lot, S. 11 1/2 W. 139 feet to stake on Dunbar Street; thence with the Northern side of Dunbar Street in an Easterly direction 40 feet to the point of beginning."
