To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Gussie Orr Ledford  
in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these  
Presents, am well and truly indebted to The First National Bank of Greenville,  
S. C. and Alice Burnett Cleveland as Executrix of the Estate of W.C.  
Cleveland, deceased, in the full and just sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars  
to be paid Twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars per month  
Each payment first to be applied to the interest and then to the principal

with interest thereon from date  
at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage  
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises  
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to  
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Gussie Orr Ledford  
in consideration of the said debt and  
sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said First National Bank  
of Greenville, S. C. and Alice Burnett Cleveland as Executrix of the  
Estate of W.C. Cleveland, deceased according to the terms of the said note, and also in  
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Gussie Orr Ledford  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Bank and Alice Burnett Cleveland  
as Executrix of the Estate of W.C. Cleveland, deceased  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,  
sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said First National Bank  
of Greenville, S.C. and Alice Burnett Cleveland as Executrix of the  
Estate of W. C. Cleveland, deceased, their successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County  
of Greenville, State of South Carolina being known as Lot No. 22 of the  
J. R. West property according to the plat made by A. S. Bedell and  
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C  
at page 190 and having, according to said plat, the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Calvert  
Street, which iron pin is situate 135.5 feet east of the intersection  
of West Street and Calvert Street and running thence along the northern  
side of Calvert Street N. 75-02 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along  
the line of lot No. 23 N. 16-34 W. 146.5 feet to the rear corners of  
lots 16, 17, and 23; thence along the line of lot no. 17 S. 75-02 W.  
60 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of lot no. 21 S. 16-34  
E. 146.5 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning. This being the  
same property conveyed to Gussie Orr Ledford in Deed Book 196 at page  
339.
