# MORTGAGE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

WHEREAS: I, William R. Jarrell

, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Seventy-seven Hundred Dollars (\$ 7700.00 ), with interest from date at the rate of four & one-half per centum ( 4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association in Greenville, S. C., or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-eight and seventy-two one-hundredths Dollars (\$ 48.72 ), commencing on the first day of October, 19 54, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of September, 1974 .

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina;

All that lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 6 on plat of Paris Mountain Gardens subdivision, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book EE page 7, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Coleman Court, the front joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 37-07 W. 155 feet to an iron pin in line of property of Tindal Estate; thence with the line of said property N. 52-53 E. 71.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 36-30 E. 155 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Coleman Court; thence with the northwestern side of said Street S. 52-53 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned;
