TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

John Wesley Methodist Church (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Two Thousand and No/100 - - - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 2000.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the southeast corner of the intersection of Court Street and Fall Street in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot 3, Block 6, Page 59 of the city block book beginning at the corner of the intersection of Court and Fall Streets and running thence along the south side of Court Street 73 feet more or less to pin at the corner of Balentine property; thence with the line of said property 85 feet more or less to pin at corner of the property now or formerly owned by Allen; thence with the line of said property and parallel with East Court Street in a westerly direction 73 feet more or less to pin on Fall Street; thence with the east side of Fall Street in a northeasterly direction 85.8 feet to the point of beginning."

Being the same premises conveyed by Samuel S. Thompson to the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church by deed dated December 17, 1895, and recorded in Book "DDD" at Page 147.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
