

All that piece, parcel or strip of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Trowbridge Avenue (Altamont Road) as recently relocated in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, between said Trowbridge Avenue and the Northern line of property of Harold R. Turner and Annie S. Turner as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Harold R. Turner and Annie S. Turner, Paris Mountain" made by Dalton & Neves, July, 1954, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Trowbridge Avenue at the joint front corner of property of M. P. Cannon and Harold R. Turner and Annie S. Turner, and running thence with the Southern side of the said Trowbridge Avenue as relocated S. 32-0 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the Southern side of Trowbridge Avenue as relocated along a curved line, the chord of which is S. 70-31 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the Southern side of Trowbridge Avenue as relocated N. 87-17 E. 34 feet to a point; thence with the Southern side of the old road line of Trowbridge Avenue the following courses and distances: S. 56-17 W. 35 feet to an iron pin; S. 87-20 W. 61 feet to an iron pin; N. 53-42 W. 63 feet to an iron pin; N. 22-20 W. 110 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

According to the plat herein referred to, the above described strip of land is all the land lying between the Southern side of Trowbridge Avenue as relocated and the property acquired by Harold R. Turner and Annie S. Turner from Henry T. Mills, Jr.
