secutive month thereafter until paid in full. Said payments to be ap-
plied first to interest, balance to principal. Interest at six per cent
to be computed on the remaining balance at the end of each six months
period, and paid along with the monthly payments on principal.

GALLOWAY, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS,

ALL those certain pieces, parcels of lots of land lying, situate and
being in **Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, and known and**
designated as lots nos. **38, 39, and a portion of lot no. 40 of Block B,**
of Sub-division known as **Norwood Heights, according to plat of said**
sub-division made by **W. D. Neves, Engineer, March, 1920, said plat being**
recorded in the Office of **R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book**
"E", at page 217; and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of **Linton Street, joint**
corner of lots nos. **37B and 38 and running thence with the common line**
