Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about seven miles North of the City of Greenville on the waters of Mountain Creek, branch waters of Enoree River, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a cement post in the North side of State Park Road and running thence N. 34-45 E. 7.12 to a stone 3 xom; thence N. 79-00 E. 10.00 to a red oak 3xom gone; thence N. 62-00 E. 4.10 to stone 3xmm in the mouth of branch; thence S. 5-10 E. 13.37 to an iron pin in the North edge of State Park Road; thence in a Westerly direction with said State Park Road 17.07 to the point of beginning, and containing 14 acres, more or less.
