To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, Ralph W. Leach and Ethel M. Leach, of Greenville County.

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand and No/100

(\$ 10,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of

One Hundred and No/100 (\$ 100.00)

Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, at the northwesterly corner of the intersection of State Park Road and Timber Lane, near the city of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 1 on the plat of Hollyvale, as recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book Y, page 131, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwesterly corner of the intersection of State Park Road and Timber Lane, and running thence along the northwesterly side of State Park Road, N. 26-20 E. 115 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 3-45 E. 95 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 31-0 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-15 W. 118.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 32; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 57-21 W. 226.4 feet to an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Timber Lane; thence with said street, S. 58-39 E. 82.7 feet; thence S. 66-49 E. 156.3 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Timber Lane and State Park Road; thence around said intersection on a curve, the chord of which is N. 68-11 E. 35.4 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty. Being the same property conveyed to us by Alline O. Cannon by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
