C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor.s in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. PEGINNING at a stake on the East side of U. S. Highway No. 25 corner of Lot #9 thence with line of said lot S 72-45 E 200 feet to a stake; thence S. 18-30 L. 100 feet to a stake; thence with line of lot no. 11 N 72-45 W. 200 feet to a stake on said Highway; thence with said Highway N 18-30 E. 100 feet to the beginning.
