I, Ernest Smith SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Ernest Smith
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont
in the full and just sum of (\$647.19) Six Hundred Forty-seven and 19/100
, to be paid Payable one year from date

, with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid in advance
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing five-tenths (5/10th) of an acre, more or less, in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the South side of the Piedmont Road, being more particularly described according to plat by W. F. Adkins, surveyor, May 16, 1939, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of the Piedmont Road and another Road; thence south 12 degrees 30 minutes west 1.78 chains to stone 3 X 0.W.; thence north 82 degrees 15 minutes east 3.00 chains to stone 3 X N.W.; thence north 12 degrees 30 minutes east 1.79 chains to iron pin 3 x N.W. in the Piedmont Road; thence with the Piedmont Road south 82 degrees 45 minutes west 2.97 chains to the point of beginning.
