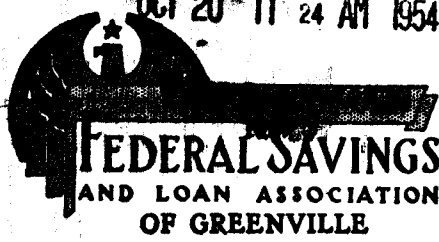

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF Greenville

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Louise Edwards Hayes, formerly Louise Virginia Hicks

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted, to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of One Thousand, Eight Hundred and No/100 - - - - -

(\$ 1,800.00 ) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of

Eighteen and No/100 - - - - - (\$ 18.00 )

Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 91 of Conestee as shown on plat thereof made by R. E Dalton, Engineer, December, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 276, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Fifth Street, joint front corner of Lots 90 and 91, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 47-42 E. 175 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 93, N. 25-01 E. 75.5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 92; thence along the line of that lot, N. 46-20 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Fifth Street; thence along the southeast side of Fifth Street, S. 42-40 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to me as Mrs. Louise Virginia Hicks by Walter T. Collins, by deed dated January 13, 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 371, at page 217.

ALSO: "All that piece, parcel or lot of land being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of Conestee as shown by a plat thereof made by Madison H. Woodard, Engineer, said lot having the courses, distances, metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corners of Lots No. 1 and 2, and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 2, N. 47-46 W. 200 feet to iron pin; thence N. 42-40 E. 60 feet to iron pin; thence S. 46-15 E. 225 feet to iron pin on Sixth Street, thence in a southwesterly direction at an angle 37.3 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Sixth Street, S 42-14 W. 31.8 feet to point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me as Louise Edwards Hayes by Henry P. Willimon by deed dated March 19, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 453, at page 350."

This mortgage also covers the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
