To All Whom These Presents May Concern

I, Doyle B. Moore,

hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagor send greeting.

Whereas Doyle B. Moore

is justly indebted to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter spoken of as the Mortgagee, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 - - - - - Dollars

(\$ 15,000.00), lawful money of the United States which shall be legal tender in payment of all debts and dues, public and private, at the time of payment, secured to be paid by that one certain note or obligation, bearing even date herewith, conditioned for payment at the principal office of the said C. Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 - - - - -

Dollars (\$ 15,000.00)

with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum, said interest to be paid on the - - - - - day of - - - - - 19 - - - - - and thereafter said interest and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on the 1st day of November 19 54, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 76.01 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of September, 19 84, and the balance of said principal sum to be due and payable on the 1st day of October, 19 84; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 76.01 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of 4 1/2 per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 15,000.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns, forever, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 27 of property of Lucy L. Hindman, according to plat of Lucy L. Hindman recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book W, at page 177, and having, according to a more recent plat of Property of Doyle B. Moore, prepared by Dalton & Neves, October, 1954, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin joint front corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28 on the Western side of Chick Springs Road, which iron pin is approximately 513.5 feet from the intersection of Poinsettia Place, and running thence N. 72-41 W. 142 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing the same course, 12 feet, more or less, to the center of a creek, making a total distance of 154 feet; thence S. 31-44 W. 79.8 feet to a point on the Eastern bank of the said creek; thence S. 72-22 E. 12 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-22 E. 153.5 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 27 on the Western side of Chick Springs Road; thence along the Western side of this road, N. 16-23 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 35-25 W. 30 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

BEING the same property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by William E. Jetter, by deed dated October 18, 1954, to be recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
