WHEREAS, Mortgagor is desirous of securing the prompt payment of said note, and the several installments of principal and interest at maturity, and any extension or renewal thereof, and any agreement supplementary thereto, and any additional indebtedness on account of any future advances or expenditures made as hereinafter provided, and the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained;

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 51.71 acres, more or less, according to plat of property of John E. Baskin; thence with the line of Baskin; south 61 degrees 30 minutes east 601.92 feet to an ironoin; thence continuing with the line of Baskin, north 23 degrees 45 minutes east 208.56 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the line of Baskin south 47 degrees 45 minutes east 417.12 fect to an iron pin; thence still with line of Baskin, north 23 degrees 45 minutes east 220.44 feet to an iron pin; thence south 53 degrees 30 minutes east 561 feet to a stone; thence south 22 degrees 30 minutes west 1148.4 feet to a Post Oak; thence north 75 degrees 00 minutes west 71.28 feet to a stone; thence south 25 degrees 30 minutes west 705.4 feet to an iron pin; thence south 5 degrees 30 minutes west 151.5 feet to a point in the center of a county road; thence with the center of said county road the following courses and distances; North 69 degrees 03 minutes west 365 feet to a bend; north 40 degrees 35 minutes west 126.5 feet to a bend; north 4 degrees20 minutes west 62 feet to a bend; north 10 degrees 09 minutes east 600 feet to a bend; north 10 degrees 32 minutes west 100 feet to a bend; north 49 degrees 58 minutes west 121.8 feet to a bend; north 61 degrees 24 minutes west 500 feet to the point of beginning.

BEGINNING at a point on the southwest side of the Neely Ferry Road at corn and property now or formerly of Mrs. W. A. Brook and running thence along the line of more, north 60-3/4 degrees west 16.00 chains to a point on the east side of a new county road; thence along said road, south 29-2 degrees west 10.15 chains to a stone on property of J. E. Baskin; thence along the line of Baskin, south 32-1 degrees wast 19.16 chains to a fence post (now a stone) at corner of land now or formerly of D.
