TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Fred Hollendorfer

, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

, a corporation
organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter
called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eleven Thousand Five Hundred
Dollars (\$11,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of four & one-half per centum
(4½%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of
C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, S. C.
or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of
Fifty-eight and thirty-one one-hundredths Dollars (\$58.31),
commencing on the first day of January, 1955, and on the first day of each month there-
after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest,
if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of December, 1984.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, state of South Carolina,
near the city of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 137
on plat of Sherwood Forest recorded in plat book GG pages 2 and 3 of
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to a
recent survey made December 1954, by R. W. Dalton, the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Lady Marion
Lane, the front joint corner of lots Nos. 137 and 138, and running
thence with the joint line of said lots S. 27-14 E. 180 feet to an
iron pin in line of lot No. 189; thence with the rear line of lots
139 and 190, N. 62-46 E. 70 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 136;
thence with the line of said lot N. 27-14 W. 180 feet to an iron pin
on the southeast side of Lady Marion Lane; thence with the southeastern
side of said Street S. 62-46 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belong-
ing or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be
had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter
attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and
assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple
absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the
