ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the South side of High Valley Boulevard, near the City of Greenville, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 48 on plat of Fresh Meadow Farms, made by M. H. Woodward, Engineer, May 21, 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "M", page 127; said lot fronting 87 feet along the South side of High Valley Boulevard, and running back to a depth of 250 feet on the East side, to a depth of 250 feet on the West side, and being 87 feet across the rear.
