

that the board of trustees of the mortgagor, its successors or assigns, may make a temporary appointment to fill any vacancy in the office of the trustee until a permanent appointment shall be made in the manner above specified.

COVENANTS AS TO RECEMPTION OF NOTES

And it is hereby further covenanted and agreed that the Mission, for itself, its successors and assigns, reserves the right to redeem all or any of the bearer notes on any interest due date, and prior to the maturity of the note, upon payment of the par value of the note redeemed in the discretion of the trustee of the Mission.

The mortgagor shall deposit with the trustee periodically the amounts necessary to meet principal and interest payments according to the obligation of the bearer notes issued pursuant to this mortgage.
