NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as a part of Lots Nos. 4 and 6, of Unit 3, as shown on plat of Pinecrest Farms, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 3, and being more particularly described, according to a recent survey prepared by C. C. Jones, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of White Horse Road Extension, at corner of Lucille Avenue, and running thence with the eastern side of Lucille Avenue, S. 0-38 E. 110.5 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Spring Brook Drive; thence with said drive, S. 6-35 E. 126 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-38 W. 132 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of White Horse Road Extension; thence with said road, S. 62-42 W. 65 feet; thence continuing with said road, S. 64-14 W. 61 feet to the point of beginning, including the plumbing, heating, and electrical fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty."

This is the same property conveyed to me by J. B. Arrowood by deed dated February 2, 1955, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 517 at Page 529.
