All of that lot or parcel or lot of land in Greenville County

South Carolina, in the Subdivision known and designated as New Furman Heights, and being Lot No. 14 thereof, according to a plat made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, in July, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book EE at page 75, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on Longforest Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 25-00 W. 173.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 73-44 W. 39.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, N. 25-00 E. 186.6 feet to joint front corner of lots Nos. 13 and 14 on Longforest Drive; thence with Longforest Drive 88.5 feet to the point of beginning.
