TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, John Wayman Griffith

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of **Twenty-Nine Hundred and No/100- - -**

**DOLLARS (\$ 2900.00**), with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six (6%)** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein statéd, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Austin Township, about one and one-half miles from Mauldin, on the road leading from Mauldin to Pelham, and having according to plat made by J. C. Hill dated June 19, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a nail cap in the center of the road leading from Mauldin to Pelham, this being the Southwest corner of the original tract of W. H. Vaughn, and running thence with the original line of the Vaughn tract, N. 1 W. 225.6 feet to iron pin; thence N. 73-15 E. 105.2 feet to pin; thence S. 20 E. 190.8 feet to pin on the Southern edge of road; thence with said road, S. 64-15 W. 181.2 feet to the beginning corner, containing 68/100 of an acre. Bounded on the East and North by lands now or formerly owned by Frank B. Jones, on the Western side by lands of Evie V. Jones, and on the South by W. H. Vaughn, and the road leading from Mauldin to Pelham."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

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
