All those pieces, parcels or lots of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 60 and 61, Pleasant Valley, as per plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "BB", page 163; said lots having a frontage of 120 feet on the Southwesterly side of Prince Avenue, a depth of 175 feet on the Northwest, a depth of 175 feet on the Southeast and 120 feet across the rear; said lots being 544.1 feet from the intersection of Prince Avenue and Pleasant Ridge Avenue.
