all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the west side of West Faris Road and being a portion of Lot No. 6 and a portion of Lot No. 5 of the property of John T. Davenport on unrecorded plat drawn by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March, 1924 and being more particularly shown on a revision of said plat drawn by Piedmont Engineering Service for Memorial Methodist Church (now Trinity Methodist Church) on July 23, 1948, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the west side of West Faris Road in the line of Lot No. 5, according to the John T. Davenport plat hereinabove referred to, said pin being 360.6 feet from the south side of the Augusta Road, and running thence N. 69-0 W. 180.6 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 5 of the Davenport plat hereinabove referred to; thence S. 21-23 W. 70 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 6 on said Davenport plat at the joint rear corner of property herein mortgaged and property heretofore conveyed by Trinity Methodist Church (formerly Memorial Methodist Church) to T. M. McNeill (See Deed Book 369, page 113, office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County); thence along the line of property of T. M. McNeill, S. 69-0 E. 181.1 feet to an iron pin on the west side of West Faris Road in the line of Lot No. 6 as shown on said Davenport plat, joint front corner of property herein mortgaged and property of T. M. McNeill; thence along the west side of West Faris Road, N. 21-00 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
