TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WILLIAM E. UNTHANK and LYDA MAE UNTHANK
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Ten Thousand and No/100 - - -
DOLLARS (\$ 10,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, being known as Lot 12, Block B, of Oakland Heights, according to Plat by W. D. Neves, June 1941, recorded in Plat Book F, at page 204, and a survey made by R. E. Dalton August 1942 and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Mountain View Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13, Block B, said pin being 75 feet West from the Southwest corner of intersection of Mountain View Avenue and Townes Street, and running thence with the line of lot 13, S. 9-45 W. 170.6 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of a 19 foot alley; thence with said alley, N. 80-15 W. 75 feet to a stake; thence with the line of lot 11, N. 90-45 E. 170.6 feet to a stake on the Southern side of Mountain View Avenue; thence with said Avenue, S. 80-15 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property being the same conveyed to the Mortgagors by Deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 395, at page 490.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
