ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Northwest side of Tipperary Lane, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 8 and the adjoining 30 feet of Lot No. 9, Block "C", on plat of Mayfair Estates, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book S, pages 72 and 73; said lot fronting 80 feet along the Northwest side of Tipperary Lane, running back to a depth of 150 feet on the Southwest side, to a depth of 150 feet on the Northeast side along line of Lot No. 7, and being 80 feet across the rear.
