with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually as stated above until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

E.D. Pace and his heirs and assigns:

All that certain parcel or tract of land containing Forty-one and 63/100 (41.63) Acres, more or less, situated about three miles from Gowensville, in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, bounded by lands of Kellogg, Lawrence Hyder and others, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at the corner of the Kellogg land, formerly T.G. Pace, and running thence N. 25.50 E. 1760 feet to a stone, formerly T.M. Belue land; thence S. 75.44 E. 1222 feet to a stone, corner of lands formerly belonging to the Earle Estate; thence S. 44.06 W. 815 feet to a stone; thence S. 27.20 W. 1160 feet to a stone; thence S. 68.37 W. 946 feet to the beginning corner, according to survey and plat by J.H. Atkins, dated April 4, 1928.
